



Florida PROMiSE Induction Modules

Induction modules are designed to be delivered to new teachers of grades K – 5, 6 – 8 Math or Science and 9 – 12 Math or Science. However, depending on districts' needs, Middle/High Math and Science modules can be combined into a 6 – 12 presentation. The first module from the Inservice Modules can be used for all teachers instead of just new teachers. Also, instead of providing all 10 modules to new teachers, modifications can be made to suit each district. In planning, remember that each module is intended to be three hours in length, but can be modified if needed.
