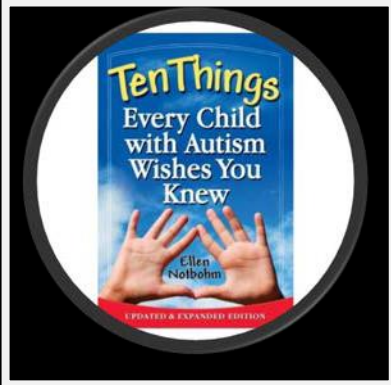


# FDLRS Heartland Presents Ten Things Every Child with Autism Wishes You Knew Book Study
